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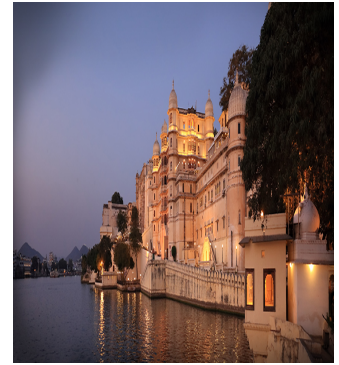

Itinerary:

Day 1: Jaipur:

Arrival at the Jaipur " Welcome To Pink City)

On your arrival at Jaipur airport, you will be received by our representative who will then lead you to your hotel. After completing your check-in formalities, you can head out to take a tour of the city.

Your first destination in the city has to be the very renowned City Palace of Jaipur. The City Palace is a vast complex that consists of many courtyards, palaces, and gardens. However, the highlights of the palace are the Mubarak Mahal and the Chandra Mahal. The architecture of the palace is something that will astound you even further, with a blend of Mughal and Rajasthani cultures, the designs and carvings enhance the charisma of the place.

Right outside the palace is numerous local shops that offer authentic Rajasthani products. You can check them out and see if you like something to take back home.

Later on, you can make your way back to the hotel for the night stay and dinner.

Day 2: Jaipur:

Sightseeing in Jaipur

After a healthy breakfast at the hotel, you will be heading out for sightseeing on day 2.

Your first destination will be Nahargarh Fort. The unique feature of the fort is that each room in this fort is connected through common corridors. They are also decorated with delicate wall and ceiling paintings. It is even said that the fort was built around the jungle because the kings of Jaipur used to take a keen interest in hunting.

The next destination for the day is Choeur Ghati. While you trek up to the Ghati, you can explore the Sun temple, Choeur palace and also a lake situated in the woods. Locals say that the view of the trail is so mesmerizing that even they keep visiting the place every now and then.

The last destination for the day is the Jantar Mantar Observatory. The observatory houses the largest instruments in comparison to the 5 other observatories in India. Jantar Mantar of Jaipur has also been declared as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO and it serves as one of the major tourist attractions in the city.

After the tour of this observatory, you can head back to your hotel and catch up on some sleep.

Day 3: Pushkar:

Travel Jaipur to Pushkar (148.0 kms / 2 hours 36 minutes)

Today you will be heading to the city of Pushkar. The distance you need to cover is 148 km and it should take you around 2 hours 36 minutes, by road, to reach your destination.

As soon as you finish your check-in process at the hotel, you can start exploring the city. Your first destination for the day will be the Pushkar Ghats. The place is an architectural marvel and its spiritual vibe is an additional plus point to the place. Many tourists visit the lake just for a dip in the holy water, it is said that it helps you attain nirvana and spiritual peace. You would know better, once you take a dip yourself.

Later on, you can head back to your hotel to catch up on some sleep.

Day 4: Jodhpur:

Travel Pushkar to Jodhpur (214.4 kms / 3 hours 49 minutes)

After an early breakfast, you will hit the road today to make your way towards Jodhpur. The distance to be covered is 214.4 km and it should roughly take you around 3 hours 49 minutes. Upon your arrival, make sure you complete your check-in process and then move to explore the city.

Your first destination will be the grand Mehrangarh Fort. The fort is known for its commendable architecture that its formidable walls. In fact, it is one of the most magnificent forts in the entire state. The ornate red sandstone carvings, the gallery of paintings, ornate palanquins, and its intricate mirror work in the Sheesh Mahal is highly spoken off.

After visiting this majestic palace-like fort, you can take a walk amidst the narrow lanes of Jodhpur and adore the beauty of the city. Post that, you can return to the hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

Day 5: Jodhpur:

Sightseeing in Jodhpur

Follow your breakfast routine and then move out to the city to visit some more attractions.

You will begin with the Umaid Bhavan Palace. The youngest palace of India was built right before India attained Independence. The palace is home to the Jodhpur royal family and currently it is the world's sixth-largest private residence. Now the best part about the palace is that it has one thing in common with the iconic Taj Mahal, the palm court marble used in its construction.

Your next destination will be the amazing Balsamand Lake. The lake is located amidst a manicured garden full of mango, papaya, pomegranate, guava, and plum trees. In fact, you can also spot the peacock at times. Go to this place for the natural beauty and picturesque view.

Before you end your day, visit the Shastri Circle. The circle is a lovely and vibrant part of the city. It is considered to be a lively hangout spot for the locals. This is an ideal spot for travelers to take a break from all the tourist spots and just enjoy a relaxed and entertaining evening. Look out for the light show and musical fountain.

End your day, by heading back to your hotel.

Day 6: Udaipur:

Travel Jodhpur to Udaipur (249.6 kms / 4 hours 32 minutes)

Get ready for yet another road trip, from Jodhpur to Udaipur. The distance you will be covering is around 249.6 km and it should take you around 4 hours 32 minutes. So make sure you have an early but filling breakfast.

Day 7: Udaipur:

Sightseeing in Udaipur

Today will be the last day of your tour, so be all charged up after a healthy meal in the morning and kick start your day with Fateh Sagar Lake.

The lake located at the foothill of Moti Magri is very important not only in terms of tourism but also in sustaining the water supply in the city. Motorboat rides are one of the most popular water sports offered at the lake. These boats take you around the lake and allow for an up-close view of the hills.

After a tranquil boat ride, spend some time at Sahelion Ki Bari. The English translation of Sahelion Ki Bari is “Garden of Maids”. It is said that the Kings used to enjoy around the pools and fountains of this garden. In fact, these fountains were imported all the way from England. The garden also houses a museum that is worth a visit.

Your final attraction in the city is the Ambrai Ghats. The ghat is popular for its lakeside view and all you will experience at this place is peace and fond beauty. This lakeside ghat is surrounded by beautiful lakes and hotels. Also, it provides you with the view of Gangaur Ghat, the place where a scene from the movie “Goliyon Ki Rasleela Ram-Leela” was shot.

Later on, head back to your hotel and start packing for your departure on the next day.

Day 8: Mount Abu:

Travel Udaipur to Mount Abu (164.1 km. / 2 hours 50 minutes)

Today you will be traveling to Mount Abu. The destination is 164.1 km away and it should take you around 2 hours 50 minutes to reach Mount Abu. So, have a filling breakfast and get set to hit the road.

Upon your arrival, complete your check-in process and move out to explore the city.

Your first destination is the Mount Abu Wildlife Sanctuary. The Mount Abu Wildlife Sanctuary is one of the most established parts of the Mount Abu mountain ranges. The sanctuary is the hub for creatures and winged animals and is around 7 kilometers in length and just 300 meters wide. This implies that while you are strolling through, you won't miss much on either side.

Post this tiring visit, head back to your hotel for a good night's sleep

Day 9: Departure:

Begin your day with a healthy breakfast and then re-start with your city tour. Your first destination of the day is Guru Shikhar View Point.

The highest point in all of Mount Abu offers you an amazing view of the entire city. All we can say is do not forget your cameras. You will be able to click some of the most scenic shots of your entire tour at this attraction point. There is also a temple built at this spot, you can visit the temple before you start descending the hill.

Your next checkpoint in the city is Peace Park. The Park is both flawless and tranquil. There is a recreation center that is settled between two tops of the Aravalli. The park is the perfect place for kids and for the ones who want to spend some time around nature.

Your last destination is Nakki Lake. Nakki Lake is one of the best places to visit in Mount Abu. On one hand, if it is the largest manmade lake in India then, on the other

hand, it is romantically called the love lake of Mount Abu. To add to this it is also the sacred lake for the proud Garcia tribe. But apart from this, the highlight of the lake is its sunset. Go there for the sunset and you will not regret it.
