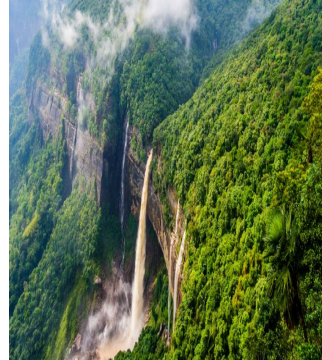
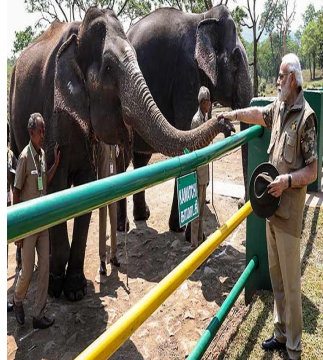

Day 4: Shillong:
