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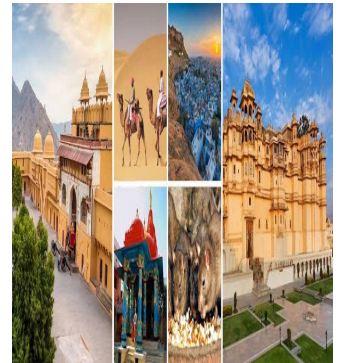
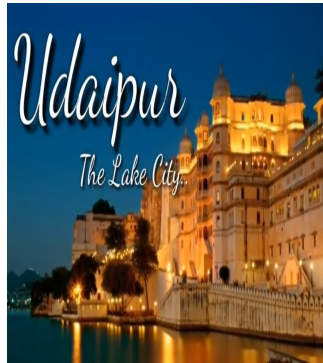

### Itinerary:

#### Day 1: Udaipur:

##### Day 1: Udaipur Arrival

Upon arrival in Udaipur, meet our tour representative/Driver who will help you transfer to the pre-decided hotel. Udaipur – Titled as the ‘city of lakes’, Udaipur is one of the best cities in the world. A number of lakes and palaces adorn the city and add to its timeless beauty.

Complete the check-in formalities and spend rest of the day doing leisurely activities. If Time allow you can enjoy the Dance show at Bagore ki haveli. Enjoy an overnight stay at the hotel.

#### Day 2: Udaipur:

##### Day 2: Udaipur (A visit of The City of Lakes)

On this day, you are going to visit popular forts and palaces in one of the romantic cities. Enjoy exploring the City Palace which represent the splendor that was cherished by the rulers of Mewar centuries ago. Visit Saheliyon-ki-Bari, a garden with flowers, lily ponds and marble fountains etc. Marvel at the Lake Palace which is built with marble and is the most romantic hotel situated amidst a lake. It also offers scenic views of the surroundings. ther attractions are Fateh Sagar Lake, an artificial lake famed for its azure water and ethereal beauty and Jagdish Temple, a massive temple situated in the heart of the city and dedicated to Lord Vishnu. Take a trip to the Pratap Memorial, Bharatiya Lok Kala Mandir and Pichola Lake – a picturesque lake which boasts of sublime beauty and scenic surroundings. In the evening, you will be headed towards the Lake Pichola to enjoy the motorboat cruise amidst the enchanting beauty of the calm and tranquil waters of the lake on additional cost. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

#### Day 3: Jodhpur:

### **Day 3: Udaipur – Kumbhalgarh - Ranakpur – Jodhpur (260 Kms /5-6h)**

Savor a delicious breakfast and head towards Jodhpur. Enjoy a halt en route at the Kumbhalgarh fort Kumbhalgarh also known as the Great Wall of India is a Mewar fortress on the westerly range of Aravalli Hills, in the Rajsamand district near Udaipur of Rajasthan state in western India. It is a World Heritage Site included in Hill Forts of Rajasthan. It was built during the 15th century by Rana Kumbha. Later we visit the Ranakpur Jain Temples. Dedicated to Tirthankara Rishabhanatha, these temples are a revered pilgrimage site for the followers of Jainism. Considered as one of the largest temples, they include several other temples within the campus like the Surya Temple, Chaumukha Temple, Amba Temple and the Parshwanath Temple. Once done with exploring the temples, resume your trip towards Jodhpur. After reaching check-in at the hotel at Jodhpur, popular as the blue city in Rajasthan. It is situated on the boundary of the Thar Desert. Enjoy an overnight stay at the hotel.

#### **Day 4: Jodhpur:**

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### **Day 4: Jodhpur (Full day excursion of The Blue City)**

In the morning take your healthy breakfast and Later get ready for the explore “The Blue City of Rajasthan.” You are going to visit the Mehrangarh Fort – a spectacular fort perched upon a hill and offering panoramic views of the Jodhpur city and Jaswant Thada. Later we explore Umaid Bhavan Palace Museum – almost 75 years old architectural marvel now turned into museum showcasing artistic murals, opulent miniature paintings, vintage clocks and unusual household paraphernalia. Jaswant Thada –also known as the Taj Mahal of Mewar and a charming sight to behold. In the evening we have free time for shopping. Stay overnight at hotel.

#### **Day 5: Jaisalmer:**

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### **Day 5: Jodhpur – Jaisalmer (284 Kms /5-6h)**

Be ready for yet another road trip, this time to Jaisalmer. The distance you need to cover is 284. kms and it should take you around 5 hours to reach your destination. So, make sure you have an early breakfast and hit the road to reach your next city. On your arrival, complete your check-in process and visit the Gadisar Lake. There are numerous shrines and small temples on the embankment of this lake. There is also a big domed pavilion in the center of the lake which is quite an attraction. Also, watch out for the different species of birds, which migrate from distinct places. Stay overnight at hotel.

#### **Day 6: Jaisalmer:**

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### **Day 6: Jaisalmer – Desert (50 Kms / 1-2h)**

After following your breakfast routine at the hotel you can start with exploring the city. Your first destination of the day will be the Jaisalmer Fort. Jaisalmer Fort is one of the world's largest fully preserved forts. It was built back in 1156AD and it derives its name from two words – Jaisal and Meru. Due to its yellow colour which glows like gold in the morning and evening, it's also known as the Golden Fort or Sonar Quila. After visiting the fort, you can head towards the Jaisalmer Government Museum. The museum houses a great collection of wood and marine fossils and gives an insight into the geological past of the area. The important attractions of the museum are paintings, sculptures, inscriptions, coins, embroidered dresses, handicrafts etc. You

can also visit the havelis like – Nathmal Haveli, Patwa Haveli, Salim Singh Haveli. Later visit the Vyas Chatri and in the afternoon explore the Kuldhara (an abandoned village in the Jaisalmer). Now you are going to visit the Sam Desert for some adventure activities. They say that if you are in Jaisalmer and you haven't explored the desert activities; your tour is a waste. we go for a unique experience of the Desert alike Arabian night by making overnight stay over sand dunes with tented accommodation with cultural program and also enjoy photogenic sunset on camel back. Dinner and Stay overnight at the Camp.

### **Day 7: Jaisalmer:**

### **Day 7: Departure from Jaisalmer**

On the last day of the Jewels of Rajasthan tour, after having your breakfast, get ready to bid farewell to Jaisalmer with lots of memories. You will be transferred to the Airport or Railway station to board the flight or train towards your onward destination.
