Day 1: Kashmir:

#### **Day Excursion to Pahalgam**

After and drive to Pahalgam (Valley of Shepherds) via old part of Srinagar. Drive through Saffron fields, visit Awantipura ruins (1100 years old temple of Lord Vishnu built by King Awantiwareman), Saffron fields & Bat factory. Drive through the pine forest and along Lidder River. The total distance of about 98 kms will be covered in about 2 hrs. One can enjoy a pony ride through thick pine forest. Evening Return to your reserved accommodation & overnight stay in your hotel in Srinagar.

Day 3: Kashmir:	

#### **Day Excursion to Gurlmarg**

After breakfast, drive to Gulmarg (Meadow of Flowers) 2730 Mts. above sea level. The distance of 58 kms will be covered in about 1 &half hrs. Gulmarg has one of the best Ski slopes in the world and highest golf course of the world with 18 holes. One can also have the view of Nanga Parbhat if weather permits. The view enroute from Tangmarg to Gulmarg is fascinating. One can also have a short trek upto Khilanmarg which can be covered in about 3 to 4 hrs or enjoy a cable car ride which takes to the highest point. Evening Return to your reserved accommodation in SRI NAGAR.& overnight stay back to your hotel in Srinagar.

# The Mughal Gardens:

With terraced lawns, cascading fountains, paintboxbright flowerbeds with the panorama of the Dal in front of them - the three Mughal Gardens of Nishat and Shalimar are the Mughal Emperors' concept of paradise and are today very popular places for picnics and excursions.

#### **Nishat Bagh:**

Situated on the banks of the Dal Lake, with the Zabarwan Mountains as its backdrop, this "Garden of Love" commands a magnificent view of the lake and the snow capped Pir Panjal mountain range which stands far away to the west of the valley.

#### Pari Mahal:

Pari mahal (Palace of Fairy), 3 Km ahead of Chashmashahi garden, was a school of astrology built by eldest son of Shah Jahan, Prince Dara Shukho, who had keen interest in observation of stars & Sufism. **Afternoon City Tour:** Drive through old part of Srinagar city and visit the famous Jamia Masjid, Shah-E- Hamdan Mosque, Wooden Mosque and walk-through Heritage buildings, old spice market and ancient lanes of Srinagar city.

## **Indira Gandhi Tulip Garden:**

Dubbed the largest tulip garden in Asia, the Indira Gandhi Memorial Tulip Garden is one of the must-visit places in Srinagar that sits at the foothills of Zabarwan Mountain. A seven-terraced garden is known for its 48 varieties of tulip flowers.
