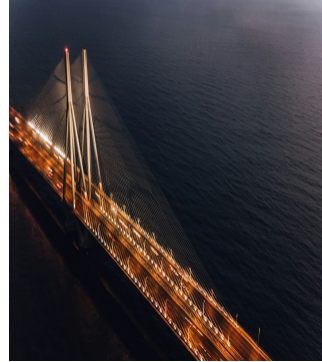
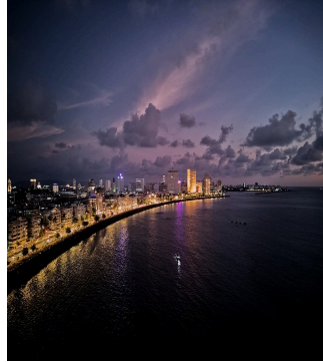

Get an unforgettable walking trip to one of the city's largest cottage industry area - They call it slums, and get to know the daily life of locals. The following day, follow your guide and discover Mumbai after sunset in an incredible walking tour.

Unique Experiences :

Day 1: Mumbai:

Welcome to Mumbai - The financial capital of India! Upon arrival, look for the man holding a signboard with your name on it at the exit point of the arrival hall. This is our local representative who will transfer you to your hotel in local style.

Transportation: Mumbai Airport (BOM) to Mumbai Hotel by Car or Van
Accommodation: Over night at hotel (budget or comfort as per booked)

Day 2: Mumbai:

Enjoy the morning on your own by visiting the Gateway of India or relax to battle jet lag if you have arrived from a long journey or late in the night. Later, you will go for a Dharavi slum tour. To participate in this tour, you need to reach the Eros cinema, no later than 13:30. Eros Cinema is opposite Churchgate railway station.

On this tour, you will see the area which is the heart of small-scale industry in Mumbai. Many people know Dharavi as the 'largest slum in Asia,' but there is much more to this historic area of Mumbai than poverty. When passing through the residential spaces, you will undoubtedly feel the sense of community and spirit that exists in the area. People from all over India live in Dharavi. This tour takes you to the following areas, which become the highlight of this trip as well:

Recycling area: Old computers, parts and plastics come from all over the world to Dharavi to be recycled. See the recycling plants in which the separation and melting of plastics take place.

Biscuit bakery: Tea biscuits and snacks that one can buy anywhere in Mumbai are made here - hot and fresh at the source.

Popaddom making: Watch the women of Dharavi make poppadoms, the essential appetizer of any Indian meal, by sun drying them on wooden baskets that are turned upside down (Seasonal).

Leather Industry: Dharavi is known for its leather industry, in fact, the biggest business in Dharavi is leather. You will learn how the skins of animals are Tanned, Washed, Ironed, and Painted to make the final leather products

Kumbharwada pottery colony: Watch artisans create all types of pots out of unfired, sun-dried clay;

Local School: This underprivileged school is supported by funds from the tour, more of which will be explained by your guide on the tour.

The trip ends at around 17:00 in Dharavi. After the tour, either return to your hotel or enjoy the evening alone.

Accommodation : Over night at hotel (budget or comfort as per booked)

Miscellaneous : Dharavi Slum Tour (transfer to/from starting point not included and to be arranged on own)

Day 3: Mumbai:

Morning is free at leisure.

Mumbai never sleeps and has a different atmosphere at night time. As the heat of the day evaporates teenagers, lovers, families and the elderly head out to enjoy the weather. Places like Marine Drive are crowded with Mumbaikars walking around or sitting and enjoying the gold-edged and rose-coloured sunset. This evening's trip starts at 19:00. You must reach the Eros cinema, (opposite Churchgate Railway Station) from where the tour starts. We will visit the following key places:

Chowpatty Beach: Witness friends and families enjoying this action-packed beach, consuming coconut water, ice creams and Indian snacks such as Bhel Puri, Pani Puri, Pav Bhaji etc.

Banganga Tank: Originally built in 1127 and surrounded by Hindu temples. The water from this famous tank is believed to have special healing powers. Rumour has it that its spring comes from the holy Ganges river;

Jain Temple: This is considered one of the most beautiful, intricately-decorated temples in the city. Jainism, an Indian religion, prizes peacefulness and non-violence above all.

Kamala Nehru Park: Visit one of Mumbai's greenest and most peaceful areas on top of Malabar Hill. You won't believe the extraordinary view over Marine Drive and the Arabian Sea.

Antilia building: Get a street view of the two billion dollar home of business tycoon Mukesh Ambani- of Reliance group. Ostentatious monstrosity or architectural masterpiece.

The trip ends at CST Railway station at around 21:30. Proceed to your hotel on your own.

Accommodation : Over night at hotel (budget or comfort as per booked)

Miscellaneous : Mumbai Evening Tour (transfer to/from starting point not included and to be arranged on own)

Day 4: Mumbai:

Free time at leisure until check-out. Continue to on your own

Accommodations: Three nights stay in Hotels as per the standard of tour booked

Transportation: Mumbai Airport (BOM) to Mumbai Hotel by Car or Van

Miscellaneous: Dharavi Slum Tour (day 2) and Mumbai Evening Tour (day 3)

Travelers/Guests/Customers OR booking Agents must notify Go Beyond Tours in writing on mail@gobeyondtours.in for any cancellation. We will NOT provide partial or full refunds for missed or unused services. Our cancellation policies and related fees are mentioned as a percent of the total booking price based on the booking's start date i.e. first day of service.

The following cancellation policy is applicable and applicable fees is mentioned as a percentage of total booking price for Standard Tours booked directly on our website -

- 100% refund of the total booking price IF the cancellation request is received more than 30 days prior to the travel date / first day of service.
- 50% refund of the total booking price IF the cancellation request is received between 15 and 29 days prior to the travel date i.e. first day of service.
- No refund of the total booking amount IF the cancellation is received less than 15 days prior to the travel date / first day of service.
- Compulsory cancellation fee applicable once you get the confirmation for trips with non-refundable services like train or air tickets, rides, jungle safari etc.
- Compulsory Service charge / cancellation fee applicable for customized trips / group tours as mentioned at the time of specific offers
