Day 1: Jaipur:

Jaipur

Day 2: Jaipur:

Jaipur

Today you have a guided tour in Jaipur includes a visit to the Amber Fort, Hawa Mahal, City Palace, Jaigarh Fort, and Jantar-Mantar (a scientific observatory). The picturesque capital of Rajasthan, Jaipur is color-washed pink – the color of hospitality in Rajput tradition. Jaipur displays a remarkable harmony in architectural splendor. The only planned city of its time, a formidable wall encircles Jaipur.

Transportation : Sight seeing in Jaipur by Private Car or Van

Accommodation : Overnight at hotel

Day 3: Bikaner:

Bikaner

Today, you have a long drive to Bikaner. You may start early in the day to be able to reach the village of Deshnok and visit the Karni Mata Temple (world-famous Rat temple). Time permitting; we visit the Camel-breeding farm. Bikaner retains the medieval splendor that pervades the city's lifestyle. More popularly called 'camel country', the city is renowned for the best riding camels in the world.

Transportation : Jaipur to Bikaner by Private Car or Van

Accommodation : Overnight at hotel

Day 4: Jaisalmer:

Jaisalmer

In the morning we visit the Junagadh Fort, followed up by a long drive to Jaisalmer. A visit to Jaisalmer is incomplete without a ride on a camel and of course, the view of the city during sunset. You will be driven to the desert and enjoy a camel ride in the sand dunes and watch the sun slowly disappearing in the sand during sunset. We follow this with local performances and dinner.

Transportation : Bikaner to Jaisalmer by Private Car or Van

Accommodation : Camp at desert near Jaisalmer

Day 5: Jaisalmer:

Jaisalmer

Drive from the campsite to the city and check in to your hotel. Rising from the heart of the Thar Desert is the city of Jaisalmer. A commanding fort etched in yellow sandstone dominates the amber-hued city. The life within the citadel conjures up images of medieval life with its narrow lanes strewn with magnificent palaces, Havelis, temples, skilled artisans and ubiquitous camels. Later in the day explore the city with its colorful market or go to a pond nearby named Gadi Sagar lake, where you find hundreds of cat fishes waiting to say hello to you.

Transportation : Driver at stand by to take you to sites in Private Car or Van

Accommodation : Over night at hotel

Day 6: Jodhpur:

Jodhpur

Today after breakfast, you will have a half days drive to Jodhpur. Arrive in Jodhpur and rest of the day is at your leisure. In the evening you may go to take a walk at local Bazaar / market. The famous Jodhpuri suit is considered to be a formal / business dress and alternative to the global formal coat / blazer suit.

Transportation : Jaisalmer to Jodhpur by Private Car or Van

Accommodation : Overnight at hotel

Day 7: Jodhpur:

Jodhpur

Today after breakfast, you will go around for sightseeing in Jodhpur including a visit to the Umaid Bhawan Palace, Jaswant Thada, Mehrangarh Fort and an excursion to the Mandore Gardens. The massive 15th century Mehrangarh Fort looms on the tops of a rocky hill. A major trade center of the 16th century AD, the fortress city of Jodhpur is now the second-largest city of Rajasthan. While the graceful palaces, forts and temples strewn throughout the city bring alive the historic grandeur - exquisite handicrafts, folk dances, music and the brightly attired people lend a romantic aura to the city. It was here that the popularly worn baggy – tight, horse-riding trousers – ‘Jodhpurs’ took their name.

Transportation : Driver at stand by to take you to sites in Private Car or Van

Accommodation : Over night at hotel

Day 8: Pushkar:

Pushkar

Today you will drive from Jodhpur to Pushkar which you can explore on your own. Pushkar lies along the bank of the picturesque Pushkar lake on the edge of the desert, surrounded by hills.

Transportation : Jodhpur to Pushkar by Private Car or Van

Accommodation : Over night at hotel

Day 9: Agra:

Agra

Today after breakfast you will drive from Pushkar to Agra, enroute visit Fatehpur Sikri. Once the capital of the mighty Mughals, this is now a bustling small market catering to the tourists. Later drive to Agra and check in to your hotel. In the evening, if time permits, visit Mehtab Bagh – Moonlit garden to get a glance of Taj Mahal from the backdrop of Yamuna. Overnight at hotel.

Transportation : Pushkar to Agra by Private Car or Van. Driver at stand by to go to local sites.
Accommodation : Overnight at hotel

Day 10: Agra:

Agra

In the early morning, you will visit the Taj Mahal for a sunrise view. Historic Agrabana, legendary city of the ancients, is today remembered as the capital of the Mughals and famed all over the world as the City of Taj Mahal, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. After breakfast we visit the Agra fort. Later, proceed for the drive to Delhi.

Transportation : Agra to Delhi by Private Car or Van

Note :-

- The Taj Mahal is closed every Friday, the Muslim day of rest. If your trip dates make you arrive in Agra on a Thursday then it will be advisable to do the trip in reverse order OR visit Taj on Thursday evening as it will be closed on Friday. You will see the Taj sunset view.

- Accommodations : Stay in Hotels as per the standard of the tour booked along with a night at Jaisalmer in desert camp along with dinner and breakfast.
- Transportation : Private vehicle between cities and the same vehicle available during the local sight seeing.
