Day 1: Colombo:

Upon arrival at Colombo International airport, meet our representative and get transferred to the hotel. Rest of the day at leisure, overnight at a hotel. Overnight stay in Colombo.

Day 2: Kitulgala:

After breakfast we start for Kithulgala – a small town perched on the hills that slope down to the flowing waters of the Kelani River. You will check into the hotel and relax. In the afternoon you will enjoy white water rafting, it will take about two hours, including introduction and guidance. White water rafting in the picturesque Kelani river will hopefully make this a memorable experience. Overnight stay at Kitulgala.

Day 3: Kitulgala:

After breakfast we start for Kithulgala – a small town perched on the hills that slope down to the flowing waters of the Kelani River. You will check into the hotel and relax. In the afternoon you will enjoy white water rafting, it will take about two hours, including introduction and guidance. Day 4: Nallathanniya:

After breakfast you will transfer to Nallathanniya, check in to the hotel and rest for a few hours. Later in the evening you will start to climb the Adams peak, and you can see the sunrise next day early in the morning.

4th highest mountain in Sri Lanka, this colonial mountain located in central Sri Lanka, but this is the most spiritual significant place among locals, because top of the mountain can be seen as a "sacred footprint" All religions claim or believe that this sacred footprint was formed due to the presence of their gods/lords. Buddhists who believe it should be Lord Buddha's, Hindu pilgrims who believe it was Shiva or Hanuman, and Christian believe this was Adam's.

Day 5: Nuwara Eliya:

After viewing the sunrise you come down to the hotel and have breakfast, you may rest for a few hours before checking out and proceeding to Nuwara Eliya. The beautiful town of Nuwara Eliya, set in the heart of Tea country and situated 1890 meters above sea level, is where the British succeeded in creating an English countryside with homes in styles from Georgian to Queen Anne.

Day 6: Ella:

Early in the morning (around 5:00 AM) you will visit Horton Plain National park which is the protected area in central highland in Sri Lanka and is covered by soaring mountains also it has the rich biodiversity, therefore many species can be seen, it would be 2 hours 30 minute trekking and you will see natural beauty of the central Highlands.

After that trekking you will transfer to Ella, after checking into the hotel you can rest at the hotel or you can visit Ella city with local Tuk tuk or on foot. Overnight stay in Ella.

Day 7: Ella:

After breakfast and full day leisure

After breakfast you will rest until check out. Later transfer to Udawalawe National park, after having delicious local lunch you will transfer to visit evening safari just you hop the Jeep and start, it is very famous for Elephants, but time to time you could see some animals, after ending Udawalawe Safari you will transfer to Weligama check in to the hotel and rest few times, later afternoon you can rest at the hotel or beach.

The following cancellation policy is applicable and applicable fees is mentioned as a percentage of total booking price for Standard Tours booked directly on our website -

- 100% refund of the total booking price IF the cancellation request is received more than 30 days prior to the travel date / first day of service.
