Jaipur to Agra
Today after breakfast, you will drive from Jaipur to Agra and you have a visit to Fatehpur Sikri enroute. Historic Agrabana, legendary city of the ancients, is today remembered as the capital of the Mughals and famed all over the world as the City of Taj Mahal, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Not far away is Fatehpur Sikri, known as the ghost city today, but for a one brief moment; Akbar the Great Emperor made it his capital city. After the visit you will drive to the hotel in Agra. If this is not enough then go to Mehtab Bagh - Moonlit Garden. Here get a glance of Taj from the backdrop of river Yamuna. Overnight at the hotel.
