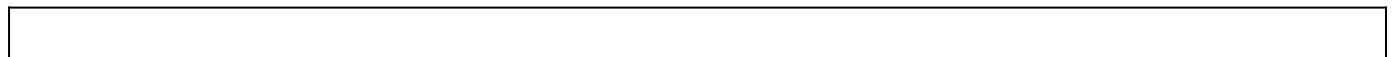
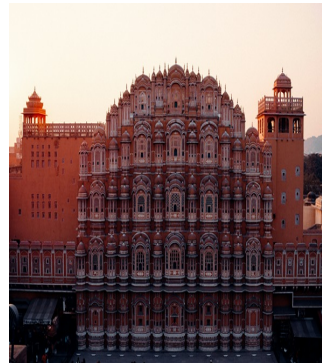

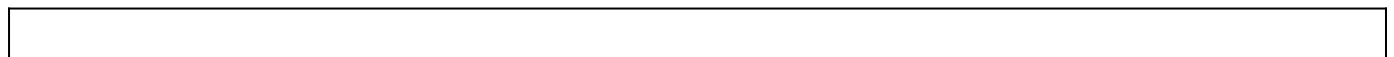

Day 1: Delhi:

Delhi

Welcome to India! Upon arrival in Delhi you will meet and will be assisted by our representative to get transferred to your Hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight at hotel.

Day 2: Delhi:

Delhi Sightseeing

Today, we start from your hotel very early in the morning (around 06:15 am). We will drive you to the meeting point from where your cycle tour will start and after meeting your guide you are ready to see Delhi from a very different perspective, from the comfort of your bicycle saddle. After Bicycle trip, get transfer to your hotel, you may relax a bit and then get ready for another amazing experience. Freshen up, at 11:00 am, you will proceed for the city tour of Delhi. You will be driven to India Gate and Presidential Palace. You will also see the Lotus Temple, Raj Ghat and Gandhi Museum. Later, we drive past Jama Masjid and the Red Fort. Drive back to the hotel and overnight at the hotel.

Day 3: Jaipur:

Delhi to Jaipur

Today check out from the hotel and then transferred to Jaipur. Arrive in Jaipur and transfer to hotel. The rest of the day is at your leisure. If time permits you may visit Birla Temple. Overnight in Hotel.

Day 4: Jaipur:

Jaipur Sightseeing

Today you have a guided tour in Jaipur includes a visit to the Amber Fort, Hawa Mahal, City Palace, Jaigarh Fort, and Jantar-Mantar (a scientific observatory). The picturesque capital of Rajasthan, Jaipur is colour-washed pink – the colour of hospitality in Rajput tradition. Built in 1772 by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, Jaipur displays a remarkable harmony in architectural splendour. The only planned city of its time, a formidable wall encircles Jaipur. Overnight at hotel

Day 5: Ranthambore:

Jaipur to Ranthambore

Today have breakfast and checkout from the hotel and get transfer to Ranthambore. After arrived check in at hotel and rest of the day is at leisure. You may visit the Fort and temple in the evening. Overnight at hotel / resort.

Day 6: Ranthambore:

Ranthambore Jungle

Early morning starts with the ride inside the jungle. The 392 Sq. Km park comprises dry deciduous forests sprawling over an undulating terrain of the Aravali and other mountain ranges. The park is one of the finest tiger reserves in the country under the Project Tiger scheme. Ranthambore sanctuary has a large number of Sambar, Chital, Nilgai, Chinkara, Langur, Wild Boar and peafowl. In addition to this, the park also boasts of Leopards, Hyena, Jackal, Jungle Cat, Sloth bear and a small population of Pythons. Back to the resort for lunch & go back to the jungle for a second ride. Overnight at a hotel/resort.

Day 7: Agra:

Ranthambore to Agra

Today after breakfast, you will drive from Ranthambore to Agra. Enroute visit Fatehpur Sikri. Arrive in Agra and check in. The rest of the day is at your leisure. Agra, a legendary city of the ancients, is today remembered as the capital of the Mughals and famed all over the world as the City of Taj Mahal, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Explore it! In the evening you may visit Mehtab Bagh - Moon lit garden to get a glimpse of Taj from the back drop of

Yamuna. Overnight in Hotel.

Day 8: Agra:

Agra Sightseeing

Today you will drive to Taj Mahal for a sunrise view of the Taj Mahal. Emperor Shah Jahan constructed it in memory of his second wife, Mumtaz Mahal. Later visit Agra fort. Rest of the day is a free day at leisure. Overnight at Agra.

Day 9: Agra:

Agra to Delhi

Today checkout from the hotel and get a transfer to Delhi. Upon reaching Delhi, your beautiful trip is now over and you may proceed for your next adventure.

Cancellation Policy -

Travelers/Guests/Customers OR booking Agents must notify Go Beyond Tours in writing on mail@gobeyondtours.in for any cancellation. We will NOT provide partial or full refunds for missed or unused services. Our cancellation policies and related fees are mentioned as a percent of the total booking price based on the booking's start date i.e. first day of service.

The following cancellation policy is applicable and applicable fees is mentioned as a percentage of total booking price for Standard Tours booked directly on our website -

- 100% refund of the total booking price IF the cancellation request is received more than 30 days prior to the travel date / first day of service.
- 50% refund of the total booking price IF the cancellation request is received between 15 and 29 days prior to the travel date i.e. first day of service.
- No refund of the total booking amount IF the cancellation is received less than 15 days prior to the travel date / first day of service.
- Compulsory cancellation fee applicable once you get the confirmation for trips with non-refundable services like train or air tickets, rides, jungle safari etc.

Fixed Departures and shared services
