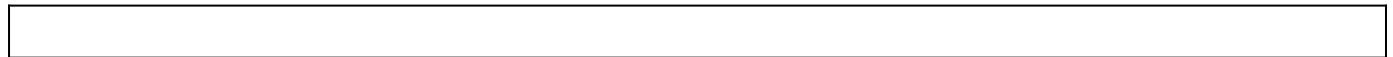

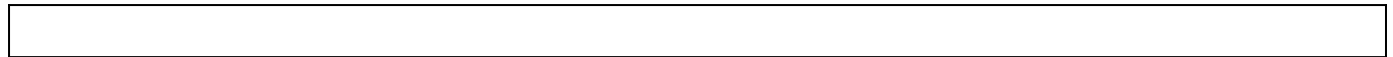

Day 1: Kathmandu,:

Arrive in Kathmandu, Bazaar Walk and Durbar Square

Mountain Flight and Sightseeing- Patan, Pashupatinath and Boudha

The view is rewarding and the flight is full of high voltage curves and turns. The passengers could get a chance to get the best view from the front. Later, we go for sight seeing in Kathmandu.

Lalitpur or Patan is considered to have been traced back to the 3rd-century BC by the Kirat dynasty which was later extended by the Licchavis in the 6th-century. This historical city near Kathmandu is famous for its Durbar Square, Uku Bahal monestary, Royal Palace, Sundari Chowk and ancient temple.

Later get blessed by Lord Shiva at Pashupati nath and by Lord Buddha at the Picturesque Boudha nath. Evening at leisure, over night at hotel.

Sarangkot is situated at a height of 1600 meters on Sarangkot mountain, and is known for its panoramic Mountain and Himalayan views of Dhaulagiri, Annapurna, and Manaslu, as well of as views Pokhara and Phewa Lake. Visit Sarangkot for a sunrise view. Later in the day you can visit for outdoor activities and adventures. Sarangkot has been a paragliding destination in recent years. If you are daring to do all the high voltage adventures, you have options to enjoy zip flying or sky diving today (on direct payment). Evening at leisure. Over night in Pokhara.

The following cancellation policy is applicable and applicable fees is mentioned as a percentage of total booking price for Standard Tours booked directly on our website -

- 100% refund of the total booking price IF the cancellation request is received more than 30 days prior to the travel date / first day of service.
