

Day 1: Delhi:

Welcome to India! Upon arrival in Delhi you will meet and will be assisted by our representative, to get transferred to your Hotel. Check in to the hotel you'll proceed for the city tour of Delhi. Today you will be driven to India Gate and Presidential Palace. You will also see the Lotus Temple, Raj Ghat, Jama Masjid and Gandhi Museum. Later, we drive past and the Red Fort. Drive back to the hotel and overnight at the hotel.

Day 2: Agra:

Today after breakfast, Check out from the hotel and drive to Agra. Arrive in Agra and transferred to hotel. later visit the Agra fort, Itmad-ud-daulah's tomb. Evening at leisure, Over night at the hotel in Agra.

Note: The Taj Mahal is closed every Friday, the Muslim day of rest. If your trip dates make you arrive in Agra on a Thursday then it will be advisable to do the trip in reverse order OR visit the

Taj on Thursday evening as it will be closed on Friday. You will see the Taj sunset view.
Day 3: Agra:
Today you will drive to Taj Mahal for sunrise view of the Taj Mahal. Emperor Shah Jahan constructed it in memory of his second wife, Mumtaz Mahal. After breakfast, Free day to relax and overnight at the hotel.
Day 4: Jaipur:
Today after breakfast, Check-out from the hotel and proceed to Jaipur you have a visit to Fatehpur Sikri en route. Historic Agrabana, legendary city of the ancients, is today remembered as the capital of the Mughals and famed all over the world as the City of Taj Mahal, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Not far away is Fatehpur Sikri, known as the ghost city today, but for a one brief moment; Akbar the Great Emperor made it his capital city.
Arrive in Jaipur and transferred to hotel. The rest of the day is at your leisure. If time permits you may visit Birla Temple. Over night in Hotel.
Day 5: Jaipur:
Today you have a guided tour in Jaipur includes a visit to the Amber Fort, Hawa Mahal, City Palace, Jaigarh Fort, and Jantar-Mantar (a scientific observatory). The picturesque capital of Rajasthan, Jaipur is color-washed pink – the color of hospitality in Rajput tradition. Built in 1772 by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, Jaipur displays a remarkable harmony in architectural splendor. The only planned city of its time, a formidable wall encircles Jaipur. Overnight at hotel.
Day 6: Delhi:
Today after breakfast, check out from the hotel and get transfer to Delhi, Arrive in Delhi, check in to the hotel. Free day to relax and overnight at the hotel.
Day 7: Delhi:
Today after breakfast, Check out from the hotel and get transfer to Delhi airport for your journey forth.

We will NOT provide partial or full refunds for missed or unused services. Our cancellation policies and related fees are mentioned as a percent of the total booking price based on the booking's start date i.e. first day of service.

The following cancellation policy is applicable and applicable fees is mentioned as a percentage of total booking price for Standard Tours booked directly on our website -

- -100% refund of the total booking price IF the cancellation request is received more than 30 days prior to the travel date / first day of service.
- -50% refund of the total booking price IF the cancellation request is received between 15 and 29 days prior to the travel date i.e. first day of service.
- -No refund of the total booking amount IF the cancellation is received less than 15 days prior to the travel date / first day of service.


