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## 08D Lively Langtang Trek and Tea House - 7 Nights / 8 Days

Cities Covered: >> Kathmandu-



Langtang region is a popular trekking region in Nepal that draws many trekkers every trekking season. Situated almost 50 kms north of Kathmandu valley, Langtang region hosts popular treks like Langtang Valley Trek, Gosai kunda Trek, and Tamang Heritage Trek. Although this trail is close to Kathmandu valley, it's still away from the hustle bustle and you get a different scene altogether. Lang tang is a splendid trekking area. The trek starts in a forest trail and goes all the way up to the alpine line to its range of some of the highest snowcapped Himalayan Peaks. This area is a good pick for those who want an alpine trek, yet do not have time for a longer trek in other popular trails like the Everest region. In this vast mountain scape, you will trek through remote villages, get a feel of little Tibet that borders not far north from here. You will pass by flower meadows, enjoy the view of breathtaking rugged peaks. Also if you are trekking around the spring, the splendors of blooming and blossoms of flowers would be ready to welcome you.

### Day 1: Kathmandu,:

#### **Drive from Kathmandu to Syabru Besi [1460m]**

Lets start - The road to Syabrubesi heads north from Kathmandu along the Trisuli River, via Dhunche. You will enjoy views of Ganesh Himal, terraces, green hills and many villages. After Dhunche, the valley becomes more narrow and deep. Upon arrival check in and freshen up. Plan and prepare for next morning. Evening at leisure.

**Walk Hours:** Approx. 7-8 hours

**Meals included:** Lunch and Dinner

**Overnight:** Tea House

## **Day 2: Kathmandu,:**

### **Trek from Syaburi Besi to Lama Hotel [2470m]**

Today being the first trekking day, and it's an easy hike. After breakfast we begin our trek by crossing the Bhote Koshi River. The trail gradually ascends to Bamboo (2200 m) and then to Rimche (2485 m). By the end of the day, we reach Lama Hotel, unwind and enjoy the evening. We will have dinner and stay over night.

**Walk Hours:** Approx. 6 hours

**Meals included:** Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

**Overnight:** Tea House

## **Day 3: Kathmandu,:**

### **Trek from Lama Hotel to Mundu [3550m]**

Today we need to cover the distance of 15 kms approx. The trail ascends gradually and pass Gumnachowk 2769 m, Thomna 2790 m, Ghoraabela 2972 m, Thyangsyapu 3140 m, Chyamki 3230 m and Langtang village 3430 then finally reach Mundu.

The panoramic vista of Himalayan peaks on the way from Lama Hotel to Mundu is a real treat to watch which includes Langtang Lirung, Ganesh Himal, Naya Kanga and Dorje Lakpa. The region shelters tremendous rare wildlife. The lively cultural exposition of local Sherpa and Tamang people makes your journey even more exclusive.

**Walk Hours:** Approx. 6-7 hours

**Meals included:** Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

**Overnight:** Tea House

## **Day 4: Kathmandu,:**

### **Trek from Mundu to Kyanjin [3800m]**

Early in the morning Mundu to Kyanjin Gompa trek start with crossing impressive 'mani wall' it is fourth day of Langtang valley trek. Trail ascends gradually crossing several small streams with wooden cantilever bridges. Once you reach, we shall be surrounded with mesmerizing Himalayan panorama of mountains.

**Walk Hours:** Approx. 4-5 hours

**Meals included:** Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

**Overnight:** Tea House

## **Day 5: Kathmandu,:**

### **Rest day in Kyanjin or Climb Kyanjin Ri**

You may choose an easy day after continuously trekking for some days. An acclimatization day might be needed to adjust to the increasing altitude and decreasing oxygen levels. However, it does not mean that you stay at the tea house for the entire day. You can explore the village or hike nearby hilltops. Kyanjin Gompa got its name from the monastery which has great religious significance for buddhists. There's also a famous milk processing center that produces yak

cheese. These two places are a must -visit when you are in and around Kyanjin Gompa.

If you choose to hike for better mountain views, you may go up to Kyanjin Ri (4400 m) It has great view points for a panoramic view of the Langtang Range, including the highest Langtang Lirung (7245 m), scenic valleys, frozen lakes, and pristine glaciers.

**Walk Hours:** Approx. 3 hours (up and down climbing Kyangjin Ri)

**Meals included:** Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

**Overnight:** Tea House

#### Day 6: Kathmandu,:

#### **Trek from Kyanjin to Lama Hotel [2470m]**

After our breakfast at Kyanjin and bowing towards Gompa with respect, we start to trek back. A long walk back on the same trail takes us to Langtang Village and Gadha Ghora Tabela, where you will stop for lunch. After a brief break, we continue on a steep descent to reach Lama Hotel, where we shall spend overnight. Though it might feel as a long hiking day, however, the walk is easier as most of the trails descend.

**Walk Hours:** Approx. 6-7 hours

**Meals included:** Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

**Overnight:** Tea House

#### Day 7: Kathmandu,:

#### **Trek from Lama Hotel to Syabru Besi [1460m]**

On the final hiking day of this trek, we hike back from Lama Hotel to Rimche, Bamboo, and finally to Syabru Besi. After enjoying the Himalayan view one last time, we enjoy a delicious local meal and spend the night at Syabru Besi.

**Walk Hours:** Approx. 6-7 hours

**Meals included:** Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

**Overnight:** Tea House

#### Day 8: Kathmandu,:

#### **Drive from Syabru Besi to Kathmandu**

After breakfast we drive back to Kathmandu. Do not forget to enjoy the scenic foothills and ridgeline on the way. Upon arrival in the city you may celebrate the achievements and proceed to the next stop on your own.

**Meals included:** Breakfast & Lunch

**Overnights:** None

We will NOT provide partial or full refunds for missed or unused services. Our cancellation policies and related fees are mentioned as a percent of the total booking price based on the booking's start date i.e. first day of service.

The following cancellation policy is applicable and applicable fees is mentioned as a percentage of total booking price for Standard Tours booked directly on our website -

- 100% refund of the total booking price IF the cancellation request is received more than 30 days prior to the travel date / first day of service.
- 50% refund of the total booking price IF the cancellation request is received between 15 and

29 days prior to the travel date i.e. first day of service.

- No refund of the total booking amount IF the cancellation is received less than 15 days prior to the travel date / first day of service.

**Note:** The local tea houses are basic but clean and they do not often have attached bathrooms or hot showers. The price is based on twin share and does not include any extra charge that lodge owners may levy for single rooms, attached bathrooms or hot showers (if these facilities are available) or for battery charging. We can't know in advance what they may charge for such things in the different lodges along the way, so we prefer to leave this cost out, rather than pass along an estimated charge to you.

The meal inclusions on the trek are breakfast (one set breakfast and tea or coffee), lunch (one main meal and tea or coffee) and dinner (soup, main and dessert with tea or coffee)
