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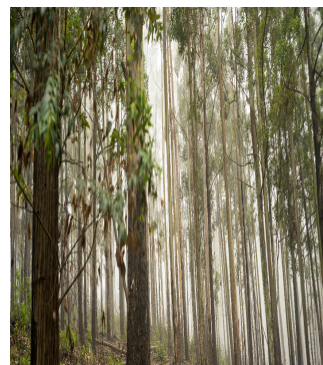
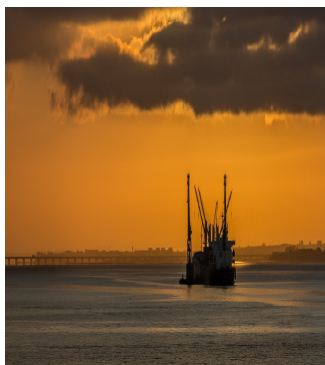

6 D Mountains of Sri Lanka - 5 Nights / 6 Days

Cities Covered: >> Colombo >> Kandy >> Nuwara Eliya >> Ella



After a smooth landing in Colombo, get ready to embrace the misty mountains and lush green side of Sri Lanka. As the train pushes through the mist, suddenly crispy green tea plantations greet you well before the train reaches the cultural capital of Kandy. You proceed to World's End by foot, and off it goes through narrow mountain roads with your personal driver. To Ella, high above the valleys where we lean back and do some Sri Lankan cooking, too. Captivating they are, those mountains of Sri Lanka.

Day 1: Colombo:

Arrive in Colombo

Arrive in bustling, shaky, colorful Colombo, with all its red and green tuk-tuks, trees with canopies shading the roads below, small cricket fields and food stalls. Transfer to a small boutique hotel. Overnight at hotel.

Day 2: Kandy:

Colombo to Kandy

After breakfast, check out and depart to Fort Railway station by 07:00 am. Board the train for a fine ride to Kandy in a class that in Sri Lanka is called 1st class. The train pushes its way through small villages with sleepy stations, station masters with green and red flags, and flowers all over. Up through the mountains. Closely past water falls, into the clouds. Upon arrival at the cultural capital of Sri Lanka, Kandy, your personal driver will welcome you and take you to your next hotel, where you feel a sense of peace, a bit away from the busy town of Kandy. After freshening

up go to Kandy view point. This will be followed by Kandian dance starting at 17:00. Later in the evening visit the temple of tooth.

Day 3: Nuwara Eliya:

Kandy to Nuwara Eliya

After breakfast your driver takes you by true mountain roads through green mountains, with tea plantations clad in light green with dots of color from the workers picking leaves, to Ramboda waterfall. You can have lunch on the way. You will visit a Tea estate, famous for a fine variety of mountain tea, to get the story of tea making. Later arrive to Nuwara Eliya at around 15:00. Check in at you hotel, and relax. Should you have some energy left, you can visit the Victoria park or do some short treks.

Day 4: Ella:

Nuwara Eliya to Ella

It will be an early start before the sun gets its grip. At this time it will be cold and crisp. You should bring a sweater, and a breakfast box. First you drive out to the Horton plains, wild moorland where you go for a trek. Suddenly you will be at the world's end and it seems like all Sri Lanka lies before your feet. Then drive back to your hotel. Later you proceed with your driver through stunning mountain scapes to Ella, the slow mountain village most people come to love. Check in, in a place overlooking the mountains and if you are still curious and your legs still fresh you can visit the waterfall and the ridge nearby for a fine sunset. If you stay back, the view is just as rewarding.

Day 5: Ella:

Ella

After breakfast and a slow relaxing morning get ready for a simple though inspiring cooking class. Try your hands in preparing some delicious Sri Lankan delicacies, and the spicy, fresh treat will be served to you for lunch. Later in the day you may just relax for a lazy afternoon or go to the beautiful Ravana falls and enjoy the scenery along the road

with colorful food stalls, large rain forest trees, slow market towns and a flow of tuk-tuks. There are also other old temple and a cave near by for a perfect evening.

Day 6: Ella:

Ella-check-out

After breakfast check out and continue on your own.

Travelers/Guests/Customers OR booking Agents must notify Go Beyond Tours in writing on mail@gobeyondtours.in for any cancellation. We will NOT provide partial or full refunds for missed or unused services. Our cancellation policies and related fees are mentioned as a percent of the total booking price based on the booking's start date i.e. first day of service.

The following cancellation policy is applicable and applicable fees is mentioned as a percentage of total booking price for Standard Tours booked directly on our website -

- 100% refund of the total booking price IF the cancellation request is received more than 30 days prior to the travel date / first day of service.
- 50% refund of the total booking price IF the cancellation request is received between 15 and 29 days prior to the travel date i.e. first day of service.
- No refund of the total booking amount IF the cancellation is received less than 15 days prior to the travel date / first day of service.
- Compulsory cancellation fee applicable once you get the confirmation for trips with non-refundable services like train or air tickets, rides, jungle safari etc.
