## 08D Kaziranga and Shillong - 7 Nights / 8 Days

Cities Covered: >> Shillong >> Kaziranga >> Guwahati



This trip to the North East will not leave your thoughts alone at any moment. Cherrapunjee which holds record of highest rainfall and is talked about for nurturing living root bridges. Visit the beautiful nature of North East and try to meet with one horn rhinos of Kaziranga national park.

### Day 1: Shillong:

#### **Guwahati to Shillong**

Welcome on arrival at Guwahati Airport / Station and transfer to Shillong (130 KMS / 3 hrs drive). Enroute visit Uiam Lake - created by damming the Uiam River in the early 1960s. The principal catchment area of the lake and dam is spread over 220 square km.

Shillong - the capital of British-created Assam until 1972 – and is now the capital and hill station of Meghalaya, also known as the Abode of Clouds, one of the smallest states in India. Overnight in Shillong.

### Day 2: Shillong:

#### **Cherrapunjee**

Morning enjoy breakfast and then set out on an excursion trip to Cherrapunjee (60 Kms / 2hrs one way). It is the traditional capital of the Nongkhlaw hima (Khasi tribal chieftainship) known as Sohra or Churra. Visit Dwan Syiem view point, Noh Kalikai falls, Mawsmi caves, Seven Sister falls, Eco Park etc. Later, I drove back to Shillong.

### **Day 3: Shillong:**

#### **Shillong Sightseeing**

Full day Local sightseeing in Shillong including The city's own Ward's Lake is popular for short garden walks & boating. The Botanical Garden offers plethora of indigenous and exotic plants & rare collection of orchids. Lady Hydari Park is a Japanese style landscaped park endowed with stretches of roses & exquisite flowers. One of the largest Golf courses in Asia is an 18 hole Golf Course that is charted amidst a surging valley full of thick pine groves & rhododendron trees. Spend the evening in the splendid arena! The State Museum is a display of the lifestyle and heritage of the people of Meghalaya (closed on Sunday). Shillong and its surrounding is dotted with splendid waterfalls cascading down deep valleys forming misty sparks as they break the silence of the surroundings. Elephant Falls is a mountain stream gorging down two successive falls set in dells of fern covered rocks. For the Bird's eye view of Shillong, one can take a stand at Shillong Peak. Overnight at Shillong.

### **Day 4: Kaziranga:**

#### **Shillong to Kaziranga**

Morning after breakfast, transfer to Kaziranga (325 Kms / 07 hrs). Kaziranga was declared a National Park in 1974 and UNESCO declared Kaziranga a World Heritage Site in 1985. The park hosts two thirds of the world population of Rhinos.

### **Day 5: Kaziranga:**

#### **National Park, Kaziranga**

Morning enjoy Jeep Safari inside the National Park. Apart from the Rhino, other species found are hog deer, swamp deer, wild buffalo, elephants and if you are lucky, the tiger. It is virtually a paradise for bird watchers, with a variety of migratory and resident birds. It's Also home to pelicans, storks and darters as there are a number of water bodies inside the Park. After breakfast at hotel you can visit tea plantations, rubber plantations. Afternoon enjoy Jeep safari in the Central Range. Evening at leisure. Overnight at Kaziranga.

### **Day 6: Guwahati:**

#### **Kaziranga to Guwahati**

Morning enjoy your breakfast and check out for transfer to Guwahati. Situated on the South Bank of river Brahmaputra this is the largest city of Assam, a major riverine port city and one of the fastest growing cities in India. Many ancient Hindu temples are in the city,giving it the name "City of Temples"; the most important being Kamakhya Temple. Evening at leisure. Overnight at the hotel.

### **Day 7: Guwahati:**

## Guwahati Sightseeing

Morning starts the Full day sightseeing in and around this capital city of Assam , covering Kamakhya Temple - Situated on top of the Nilachal Hill, Maa Kamakhya Temple is the most sacred among the tantrik shrines of Shakti worship in the world; Balaji Temple, State Museum, Navagraha Temple – dedicated to the nine planets located on the top of Chitrasal Hill, Umananda Temple on Bhasmachal - a Shiva temple located at the Peacock Island - smallest inhabited riverine island in the world , Sankardeva Kalakshetra - is a cultural institution in the Panjabari area, named after the medieval poet-playwright and reformer Srimanta Sankardev. Evening experience the river cruise Jahajghat/ Machkhowa to Jahaj Ghat/ Machkhowa river Brahmaputra (On Direct Payment). Overnight at Guwahati.

### Day 8: Guwahati:

#### Depart to Guwahati Airport

Morning Departure Transfer to Guwahati Airport / Station Tour Ends.

Note :- Kaziranga national park is closed 01st May to 30th Sep every year due to rainy season
