05D Varanasi with Train - 4 Nights / 5 Days

The land of Varanasi (Kashi) has been the ultimate pilgrimage spot for Hindus for ages. Often referred to as Benares, Varanasi is the oldest living city in the world. Being a great center of learning for ages, Varanasi is associated with the promotion of spiritualism, mysticism, Sanskrit, yoga and the Hindi language and esteemed authors such as novelist Prem Chand and Tulsi Das, the famous saint-poet who wrote Ram Charit Manas.

Unique Points on the tour:

- Come to the City of Lord Shiva and experience the Holy Ghats of River Ganges
- Immerse in the magical city known for the promotion of spiritualism, mysticism, Sanskrit, yoga and the Hindi language
- Sail down the River Ganges and float by the Ghats in the morning
- Visit Sarnath where Lord Buddha preached his first sermon in a Deer Park, trail the temples and feel the surge of the holy past

Day 1: Varanasi:

Make your way to Delhi Railway Station and board the overnight train to Varanasi.

Day 2: Varanasi:

In the morning arrive at Varanasi railway station, where the driver will wait for you to pick up from the train station and transfer you to your hotel. In the afternoon you will leave for a temple tour of Varanasi where you will visit Bharat Mata Temple, Sankat Mochan Temple, Durga Temple, and Tulsi Manas Temple. After attending the evening Aarti (worship) at river Ganges and visiting the Kashi Vishwanath Temple, we return and overnight at the hotel.

Transportation: Private Car with Driver in Varanasi

Accommodation: Overnight at hotel

Miscellaneous: English speaking guide, Aarti (worship) ceremony

Day 3: Varanasi:

.In the early morning get a boat ride and float past the ghats and then after breakfast cover the excursion trip for Sarnath temple. Sarnath, where the Buddha preached his first sermon in the Deer Park contains the most impressive remains, as well as a modern temple. The Dharmarajika, Chaukhandi and Dharnak stupas are outstanding. There are also the remains of a monastery, and the beautifully polished Lion Capital of Ashoka. Sarnath contains a rich library and at the Mula gandha Kutir Vihara there are excellent frescoes by Kosetsu Nosu.

The Sarnath Museum, not far from the site, contains some of the finest specimens of Buddhist sculpture. The illustrious Mantra, 'Buddham Sharanam Gachhami', owes its foundation to Sarnath. Besides Buddhism, it is also linked with Jainism. There is also a vast expanse of prehistoric ruins at Sarnath. Several Buddhist structures were raised at Sarnath between the 3rd century BC and the 11th century AD. The Ashoka pillar of Sarnath is the National emblem of India.

Ramnagar Fort :The Ramnagar fort is 14 kms away from Varanasi and sited on the contradictory bank of river Ganga, built by Maharaja Balwant Singh. Drive back to Varanasi, and overnight at hotel.

Transportation: Private Car with Driver in Varanasi

Accommodation: Overnight at hotel (budget or comfort as per booked)

Miscellaneous: English speaking guide

Day 4: Varanasi:

Check out from the hotel and spend the day at your leisure. Later proceed to the railway station where our representative will take you to your train for onward journey.

Transportation: Varanasi Hotel to Varanasi Railway Station by Private Car or Van, overnight sleeper train from Varanasi to Delhi

Day 5: Varanasi:

Arrive at Delhi Railway Station in the morning and proceed to your next destination on your own.
