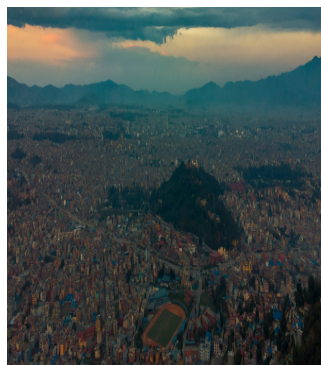

Explore Kathmandu and Namo buddha 4 Days - 3 Nights / 4 Days

Cities Covered: >> Kathmandu



Kathmandu is considered the gateway to the Nepali Himalayas and is home to several World Heritage Sites: the Durbar Square, Swayambhu, Mahachaitya, Bouddha and Pashupati nath. In old days it was also famous with the name Kantipur and was called Kastha Mandap in Sanskrit: the mystic destination in Nepal where many travelers flock in search of the ultimate adventure

Day 1: Kathmandu:

Day 1 Arrival and Evening in Swayambhu nath for the sunset view

Against the backdrop of the mighty Himalayas lies this tranquil valley called Kathmandu. Arrive at the airport while you enjoy the magical, mystic and breath taking views of Himalayas. Upon arrival check in to the airport and relax.

Swayambu Nath is considered to be the iconic image depicting Kathmandu across internet, the stupa with eyes is ready to welcome all. Beautiful Sky with colors and views are seen from Swayambhu nath Stupa. It is a popular attraction for its historical / cultural and religious significance. Beautiful architecture and interesting rituals keep happening at the temple grounds. One can spend hours in this spiritual atmosphere. Later drive back to the hotel. Overnight at Kathmandu.

Day 2: Kathmandu:

Day 2 Explore Bouddha and Pashupatinath and Namobuddha

After breakfast let's start exploring. We visit Boudhanath, which is the largest stupa in Nepal and holiest Tibetan Buddhist temple outside Tibet. After getting blessed here we proceed to another level of spirituality. The divine Pashupati nath temple is considered to be Jyotirling, dedicated to Lord Shiva and the oldest Hindu temple in Kathmandu, with its existence dating back to 400 BC or even before. Surprisingly the head priests here are mostly from South India.

Namobuddha is one of the most important Buddhist pilgrimage sites south of the Himalayas, as well as being one of the holiest Buddhist sites in the world. Situated in the Kathmandu valley, Dhulikhel is the starting point for a trip to Namobuddha. A few hundred steps later and you'll have reached a statue of Buddha. Continuing the climb, you'll find a small temple dedicated to Shiva, where there is also an entrenched encampment belonging to the Nepalese army.

This stupa is dedicated to Lord Buddha, who was at the time a young prince passing through the region. As the legend has it, Prince Siddhartha met a tigress here who was so weak she was incapable to hunt to feed her cubs. Seized with pity, the prince sacrificed himself to the tigress, who immediately devoured him. This act of compassion allowed him to attain to a superior level of existence, another step towards the Bodhi Satva. Just next to the stupa there is a Tibetan monastery, with an ocre facade richly decorated with frescos and gilded sacred elements. Later check in to the hotel and relax. Evening at leisure.

Day 3: Kathmandu:

Day 3 Explore Namobuddha and Drive to Kathmandu via Bhaktapur

If you are still lost in the stories, legends and the sayings of the area, you may continue to explore the mystic Namobuddha. Later check out and drive towards Bhaktapur.

This is another magical city which makes you feel as you have entered the time machine which has stopped for a while at the bygone era. The most attractive places to visit are Bhaktapur Durbar Square, Nyatapola Temple, Pottery Square and Dattatreya Temple. Later drive back to Kathmandu via Nagarkot. Evening at leisure. If time permits, you may do your last minute shopping today or before leaving to the airport. Overnight in Kathmandu.

Our cancellation policies and related fees are mentioned as a percent of the total booking price based on the booking's start date i.e. first day of service.

The following cancellation policy is applicable and applicable fees is mentioned as a percentage of total booking price for Standard Tours booked directly on our website -

- 100% refund of the total booking price IF the cancellation request is received more than 30 days prior to the travel date / first day of service.
- 50% refund of the total booking price IF the cancellation request is received between 15 and 29 days prior to the travel date i.e. first day of service.
