Day 1: Bodhgaya:

Bodhgaya Arrival

Arrive Bodhgaya Airport meet and greet our driver & transfer to hotel. Later Visit Mahabodhi Temple, Bodhi Tree, 80 feet high Buddha statue which is replica of Bamiyan Buddha, Sujata Village named after the lady who offered meal to Siddharth, Niranjana River which is known as Falgu River etc. Overnight stay at Bodhgaya hotel.

Day 2: Varanasi:

Bodhgaya – Varanasi (248 kms// 5hr 15 mins)

In Morning proceeds drive to Gaya visit Vishnupad temple for Rituals Pind Daan Pooja & Mangla Gauri Darshan. Come to hotel for breakfast. After breakfast proceed drive to Varanasi. Varanasi is a city in the northern Indian state of Uttar Pradesh dating to the 11th century B.C. Regarded as the spiritual capital of India; the city draws Hindu pilgrims who bathe in the Ganges River's sacred waters and perform funeral rites. Along the city's winding streets are some 2,000 temples, including Kashi Vishwanath, the "Golden Temple," dedicated to the Hindu god Shiva. In evening Ganga Aarti at Main Ghat Overnight stay at Varanasi hotel.

Day 3: Varanasi:

Varanasi

Today early morning visits the most religious Kashi Vishwanath temple, Annapurna Temple, the Bharat Mata temple, Sankat Mochan (Hanuman temple), Manas Mandir. Come back to hotel for breakfast. In the afternoon, you will be taken for an excursion to Sarnath. Sarnath is the place where Buddha delivered his first sermon to his disciples. The attractions at Sarnath are the Buddha temples, the Dhamekha Stupa, and the archaeological museum (closed on Friday). In the evening enjoy shopping of Banarasi saris and overnight stay .

Day 4: Prayagraj:

Varanasi – Vindhyachal – Prayagraj

After breakfast proceed drive to Vindhyachal a Shakti Peeth, Vindhyachal pronunciation is a city in Mirzapur district of the Indian state of Uttar Pradesh. The city is a Hindu pilgrimage site having the temple of Vindhyavasini, who according to Markandeya Purana, had incarnated to kill the demon Mahishasura. later proceed drive to Prayagraj & Overnight stay at Prayagraj hotel .

Day 5: Chitrakoot:

Prayagraj – Chitrakoot (111 Kms // 2hrs 40 mins)

After breakfast, we take Holy Bath at the confluence of Holy River three rivers, Ganges, Yamuna and invisible Saraswati. It is a holy spot, and you can find many rituals happening in the place. Later, you will be taken on a sightseeing tour that covers Anand Bhawan Museum, Hanuman temple, Swaraj Bhawan and others. Later proceed drive to Chitrakoot Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 6: Ayodhya:

Chitrakoot – Ayodhya (272 Kms // 5hr 44mins)

After breakfast Visit Chitrakoot is a pilgrimage centre and a nagar panchayat in the Satna district in the state of Madhya Pradesh, India. Connected to the Indian epic Ramayana, it is a place of religious, cultural, historical and archaeological importance, situated in the Baghelkhand region. Later Visit Valmiki Ashram, Gupat Godavari, Sati Anusuya Ashram, Hanuman Dhara, Bhart Kund etc. later proceed drive to Ayodhya Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 7: Lucknow:

Ayodhya - Lucknow (155 Kms // 2hrs 30 mins)

After having breakfast Ayodhya located on the bank of holy Sarayu river after a short while, you can see Ram Temple the birth place of Lord Ram and newly opened temple by PM Modi on 22 Jan 2024, Dashrath Bhawan(Lord Ram's father house), Kanak Bhawan means Gold which was gifted to newly married couple Ram and Seeta, Hanuman Garhi where Lord Hanuma himself lives and protect the area so called Garhi, and others nearby places. Later proceed drive to Lucknow Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 8: Lucknow:

After having breakfast you will be heading toward Lucknow the city of Nawab and known for its Museums and palaces i.e. Bada Imambada also known as Asafi Imambara, is an imambara complex in Lucknow, India, built by Asaf-ud-Daula, Nawab of Awadh, in 1784., Chhota Imambada also known as Chhota Imambara, or Imambara Hussainabad Mubarak is a monument located in the city of Lucknow, Residency and other significant sights, later dropped off at Lucknow Airport for your backward journey to home.
