Itinerary:

Day 1: Leh:

Arrival in Leh | Welcome to the Top of the World

- After arrival, reach the designated hotel in Leh.
- Gradually get acclimatized to the climate.
- Later in the evening, visit the Leh Market, Leh Palace, and Shanti Stupa on your own.
- Have delicious dinner at the hotel.
- Overnight stay at the hotel in Leh

Day 2: Leh:

Leh to Sham Valley | Exploring Borders of Leh

- Begin your day early with a delicious breakfast and prepare for an adventurous ride to the legendary 'Sham Valley'.
- Visit the confluence of the Zaskar- Indus Rivers, Hall of Fame, Magnetic Hill & Gurudwara Pathar Sahib.
- Overnight Stay & Dinner at hotel in Leh

Day 3: Leh:

Leh to Nubra Valley via Khardung-La Pass | A Drive to the World's Legendary Motorable Road (18000 ft.)

- After breakfast in the hotel, prepare yourself for the ultimate adventure as you will cross the Khardung-La pass, the most legendary motorable road at 18000 ft.
- As you descend from Khardung-la, experience the white sand dunes in Nubra and enjoy a ride of the double-humped camel, exclusively found in Ladakh
- Overnight stay at the campsite in Nubra Valley

Day 4: Leh:

Nubra Valley to Pangong Lake | Relive the Bollywood Moments

- In the morning after breakfast, ride to Pangong Lake on the Indo-China border
- Enjoy the scenic beauty with the view of the Shyok river on one side and the mountains on another side
- Overnight stay at a campsite near Pangong Lake/Tangste.

Day 5: Leh:

Pangong Tso to Hanle via Rezag La

- Morning light finds us setting off on a journey to the remote village of Hanle, home to a mere 200 families.

- The route traces the cobalt edges of Pangong Tso, leading us through Maan, Merak, and Chushul.
- At the Rezang-La War Memorial, we pay tribute to the heroes of the 1962 Indo-China War and venture to explore the world's second-largest observatory.
- Nightfall in Hanle unveils a surreal night sky, where galaxies and stars beckon with their celestial display.

Day 6: Leh:

Hanle to Umling La

- Embrace the morning sun as it calls you to a thrilling ride towards Umling La, **the World's Highest Motorable Road (18993ft.)**
- Umling La boasts remarkable terrain and serenity, offering an opportunity to pause for meditation, snap photos, and savor your achievement.
- Head back to Hanle, following the same route, and rest at your overnight haven.

Day 7: Leh:

Hanle to Leh via Chumathang | Enchanting Ride Back

- Wake up to the breathtaking view of the Changthang region, energizing you for the journey and also explore the hot springs of Chumathang
- Pay a visit to Thiksey Monastery and Rancho School
- Overnight stay & Dinner in the comfort of your Leh accommodation, reminiscing about the day's escapades.

Day 8: Leh:

Departure | It's Time to say Goodbye to the Mountains

- Fly out of Leh And it's already time to say goodbye to your fellow travelers and this magical land.
- After breakfast, we will bid you farewell and drop you at the Airport.

Inclusions :

What is included in the tour

- Meals on MAP Plan (Dinner and Breakfast) starting with Dinner on Day 1.
- Accommodation on a Triple sharing basis (General) & Double sharing basis for couples.
- Royal Enfield Himalayan Bike.

- Biking Gears (Jackets, Knee, and Elbow Guard).
- 01 Mechanic, 01 Marshall, 01 Backup Vehicle specifically for luggage.
- Fuel for the entire journey (As per the itinerary).
- Standard-size Helmets (suggest you bring your own).
- Inner-Line Permit for all restricted areas.
- Wildlife Fee and Environmental Fee.
- Sightseeing as per itinerary.
- Oxygen cylinder and basic first-aid during the tour.
- Airport Pickup and Drop (At a common time for the group).

Exclusions :

- Any meals/services not mentioned in the inclusions.
- Lunch.
- Travel Expenses.
- Security Deposit for Bike - INR 8000/bike (Refundable).
- Transport apart from the itinerary.

Cancellation Policy :

Important points to note:

1. You will have to pay a refundable security amount of INR 8000 per bike. This security amount would be refunded to you after you have returned the bike and final inspection of the bike has been done by our on ground vendor/partner. Any damage to the bike would be deducted from your security deposit. If the damages exceed the security deposit amount, you would be liable to pay the balance amount to our on ground vendor on the spot.
2. If you are unable to continue to ride the bike during the trip for any given reason, or if you decide to leave the bike at any given point during the itinerary, we will have to charge a transport fee to bring the bike back. The transport fee would depend entirely on the location where you decide to discontinue riding the bike. This amount would have to be settled on the spot and could also be deducted from your security amount if not settled immediately.
3. Please note that you are supposed to carry a Rucksack to carry your luggage and only upto 10 kg per person would be allowed. Anything exceeding that would attract a penalty of INR 500/KG.

Safety and Itinerary Changes:
